



FUNDRAISING POLICY

Funds raised for the North Bay Canoe Club should be utilized to benefit and include as many members as possible to enhance the overall paddling experience.

Fundraising

- Fundraising is to be completed by the North Bay Canoe Club to offset the costs of buying new equipment, repairing equipment and assisting in payment of club fixed costs.
 - Funds raised should be used to benefit as many paddlers as possible to enhance the quality of the overall experience
 - Decisions on specific fundraising activities and the expenditure of fundraised dollars should be made with the approval of the board of the North Bay Canoe Club
 - Individual ideas on fundraising activities or campaigns are welcomed, however must be in consultation with the Fundraising Committee of the North Bay Canoe Club
 - Accountability for fundraising dollars rest with the board of the North Bay Canoe Club.
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Sponsorship

- Sponsorship could be direct financial support in the form of infrastructure and /or equipment or services in kind
 - Sponsorship can offset the costs of regatta entries, equipment, transportation, uniforms and any other expense approved by the board
 - Sponsorship is not intended to offset individual program fees
 - Sponsorship is intended to benefit the program as a whole and not an individual paddler
 - The privacy of sponsors will be respected. Any sponsor records that are maintained by the club will be kept confidential to the greatest extent possible
 - The North Bay Canoe Club will not rent, exchange, or otherwise share its fundraising list with other organizations.
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Donations

- Donations are accepted in the spirit in which the giver intends
- No benefit may be provided to the donor
- On rare occasions, a donation may be declined as a result of a limitation proposed by the donor. These would be reviewed on a case by case basis.
